

## Chapter Display

## 1. General Rules

- a. Each chapter is eligible for competition at the state convention.
- b. The Displays must promote the current State Theme. Use of the National Theme is optional. Chapters should promote the theme(s) using examples of SAE programs, Chapter and State Activities.
- c. Displays must be no larger than 8' high from the floor x 10' wide x 6' deep. Additional size and space limitations, if any will be announced each year by the State Executive Secretary. The chapter display committee made up of delegates and supervised by chapter advisors will determine if the display meets the minimum requirements, using the Official Utah FFA Chapter display Check Sheet.
- d. Chapters should inquire in advance about the availability of electrical outlets, tables or other display needs not provided by the chapter itself.
- e. No messy or highly flammable materials (straw, hay, confetti, etc.) may be used.
- f. The first, second, and third place Display will be chosen by popular vote of the chapters attending State Convention. Each chapter will receive one vote.

## 2. Recognition

The first through third place winning chapters will be recognized on stage at the state convention with an award certificate. The first place chapter is offered the opportunity to represent the Utah FFA Association in the Hall of States display at the National FFA Convention. Chapters agreeing to do the Hall of State display qualify as state competitors and (subject to yearly funding approval) state winner funds are provided for one chapter member to travel to the National FFA Convention.
