Blue and Gold Service Award Nominations—Due January 17

Description:

The Blue & Gold Service Award honors those individuals or organizations that have been of service to the Utah FFA Association as a whole not to single chapters. Chapters or advisor organizations are asked to nominate organizations or individuals who have made a noteworthy one time service or have been of service to the association for at least 3-5 years.

Minimum Requirements:

Prior to receiving the Blue & Gold Award it is recommended that recipients receive the Honorary State FFA Degree.

Nominating/Application Procedure:

Recognition:

All Blue & Gold Service Award recipients will be presented with a commemorative plaque or pin the state convention. Recipients should be advised that business attire is appropriate for the presentation on the state convention stage.
